### Dear Parents/Carers

We are now in the final half-term of this current academic year. It has been a very busy few weeks with lots of exciting things happening at school.

Our children have been very busy undertaking some assessments in the last few weeks. Year 1 had a phonic screen check; Year 2 completed their SATs and Year 4 undertook a multiplication check. We are very proud of how well all our children have performed in these tests. The results will be included in your child's end of year report.

On Monday 12<sup>th</sup> June some of our children took part in a spoken word presentation at St Bernadette's School in Kenton. Our children, along with children in the other schools in The All Saint's Trust, focused on a wordless book about love called, Shine. This book explored how we can spread love in the world. Our children explored the book and then wrote a speech on the book. The winners from each class from Year 1 to Year 6 then represented the school at St Bernadette's. We were very proud of how well the children spoke and presented their speeches. They were amazing and a real credit to the school. We celebrated a very special event on Thursday this week when our Year 6 children joined with the other schools in our Academy Trust to celebrate a Year 6 leavers mass. This took place at English Martyrs' Church.

On Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> June, we will celebrate the 50-year anniversary of St Margaret Clitherow School. Cardinal Vincent Nichols will celebrate a mass with pupils and staff in the morning and then in the afternoon, we have invited parents and carers to celebrate with us. You will have received an invitation from your child inviting you to this event. We have also asked parents to provide some food to enjoy with the celebration. All food should be in by Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> June if possible.

# Uniform

Summer Uniform is to be worn by all children this term but I would like you to use your discretion on the days when our weather can be windy, especially the girls and the summer dresses. Boys should be wearing the yellow polo shirts and not PE T-shirts or white shirt with ties.

On the subject of uniform, can I please remind parents to ensure your child wears full PE uniform on PE days. PE is a compulsory part of the curriculum so I would also like to remind parents that all children are expected to take part in sessions. The only exception is with the express instructions of a doctor. Leggings should not be worn as they are not hygienic especially with the hot weather that we are currently experiencing.

#### **Footwear**

Please ensure that your child has the correct footwear for school. We have noticed that the same children have been asked numerous times to wear school shoes instead of trainers. Please support us with this by ensuring that your child has the correct footwear.

# <u>Jewellery</u>

Please note that jewellery is not permitted apart from stud earrings and a watch. Please, no Smart watches. Jewellery can be very dangerous and pose a safety hazard if worn during PE lessons.
