#### Edenred Summer Holidays Vouchers

The Government announced that the Household Support Fund grant has been extended until March 2024. The extended fund sets out a new requirement for Local Authorities to ring-fence a third of the funding for pensioner households, which has affected the amount the Council has available to support families with children. Brent Council will be using this funding to provide £15 supermarket vouchers per each week of the Summer holidays, for families with children eligible for free school meals. This equates to £90 for the summer holidays. The Council has made funds available through the Brent Edenred platform. This voucher should be used by families to contribute to the cost of food over the Summer holidays. Some parents will have received their vouchers yesterday, the rest will receive it via email on 20<sup>th</sup> July. The vouchers are valid for three months. If you have any issues with accessing the voucher, please contact us.

#### Holiday Activities and Food Programme (HAF)

Children in receipt of FSM vouchers are also eligible for a place on Brent's DfE- funded Holiday Activities and Food Programme (HAF.)

This means that they can access holiday activities- including a meal- for free over the Christmas, Easter, and Summer Holidays. Leaflets have been sent with your child so please check their bags. More information can be found via the link below


