# Parents' Meeting

## **Polling Day**

We have been informed that the school will be used as a polling station on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> May 2022. The school will not be open for pupils on this day. Children will be set work and teaching will be online.

## **Covid**

We are still seeing a high incident of positive cases among school children. We encourage you to test children if they have been in contact with someone who has been confirmed positive even if they are not displaying any symptoms.

To try to ensure the safety of others we ask the following:

- Avoid gatherings outside the school gates and please wear a mask if you are coming to the school office
- Every child must have tissues and wash their hands regularly.
- Please send a box of tissues in to school to be kept and used in the classroom.
- Staggered leaving times and use of different gates will remain in place. Make sure your children are dropped and collected on time for school.
- New rules state that if you or your child have a positive lateral flow test result, you should isolate straight away for 7 days without taking a PCR test. You can then leave isolation after 7 days if you have had a negative lateral flow on day 6 and 7 of isolation. If you have had symptoms, you should take a PCR test and isolate immediately for 7 days. These rules are in place from Tuesday 11th January 2022.
- Your child can still come to school if another member of the family tests positive as long as they have a negative lateral flow and no symptoms.

#### Uniform

I am concerned that our standards of uniform are slipping. Please abide by our uniform policy and ensure that your child is properly dressed for school - remembering that coats must be black or blue, boys' socks must be grey and girls' tights should be grey. Haircuts must not be grade 1 cuts with designs or gel in it and the only jewellery worn may be stud earrings and a watch that can be removed for PE. Our uniform policy is very important because it ensures that every child is equal and we are fully inclusive. If you need support with uniform then please let me know and we will help. No child should feel different here or left out because of income. Thank-you for supporting this policy. (Please see list on next page).
