Edenred Summer Holidays Vouchers

The Government announced that the Household Support Fund grant has been extended until 30 September 2022.

The extended fund sets out a new requirement for Local Authorities to ring-fence a third of the funding for pensioner households, which has affected the amount the Council has available to support families with children.

Brent Council will be using this funding to provide £10 supermarket vouchers per each week of the Summer holidays, for families with children eligible for free school meals. This equates to £60 for the summer holidays.

The Council has made funds available through the Brent Edenred platform.

This voucher should be used by families to contribute to the cost of food over the Summer holidays.

Leaver's Assembly

Year 6 entertained us all on Thursday as they held their Leaver's Assembly. The children reflected on their time here at St Margaret Clitherow and how they have grown and changed in this time.
